

Honour Among Men

A peacekeeping mission has
deadly repercussions

In this much-anticipated instalment in the award-winning Inspector Green mystery series, Fradkin challenges the many facets of Green's professional and personal life. Loyalties on the force and in his romantic life come into question as he deals with a murder which has repercussions in the military and in the political life of the country.

The fifth book in the series finds Green coping badly with a mainly administrative position within the police force, but still eager to get back into the day-to-day fray of policing.

He gets his chance when an unidentified woman is found strangled by the Ottawa River, almost within sight of Parliament Hill. She has in her possession a train ticket from Halifax and a Medal for Bravery awarded during a 1993 peacekeeping mission in Yugoslavia. What has brought this

woman to Ottawa and who is troubled enough by this visit to murder her?

The investigation leads Green to Nova Scotia, where he learns she was the witness to her fiancé's killing in a bar fight ten years earlier.

As Green and his team dig deeper into the military past, one of his female detectives is brutally beaten and may die, a street person befriended by Green in the past disappears and Green finds himself sucked not only into the murky past of a peacekeeping unit but into the high-stakes present of a federal election race.

What dark crime was committed in Yugoslavia more than a decade ago? Is someone still killing to prevent that secret from coming to light? And does the diary of a dead soldier hold the key?
